

Each year 90% of Hospice patients are cared for in their own home.

How you can access the Hospice at Home service.



1. Your local District Nurse will make a referral on your behalf to the Hospice at Home service through the Hospice at Home Co-ordinator.
2. Depending on the needs of you and your carer, the Hospice at Home co-ordinator will arrange for either a Hospice nurse or nursing auxiliary to provide care.
3. The Hospice at Home Co-ordinator will contact you or your carer directly to advise of the date and time of the nurse or nursing auxiliary's visit and their name. We will try our best to meet every request for a Hospice

nurse. However, we cannot guarantee that a nurse or nursing auxiliary will be available for a specific request.

4. The District Nurse will review your care on a weekly basis and may decide to increase or reduce the amount of care requested.

If you need to cancel a visit please contact the Hospice at Home Co-ordinator on 028 9078 1836 between the hours of 9am – 5pm. If you need to ring outside these hours please ask to speak to the Hospice Nurse on-call.

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
